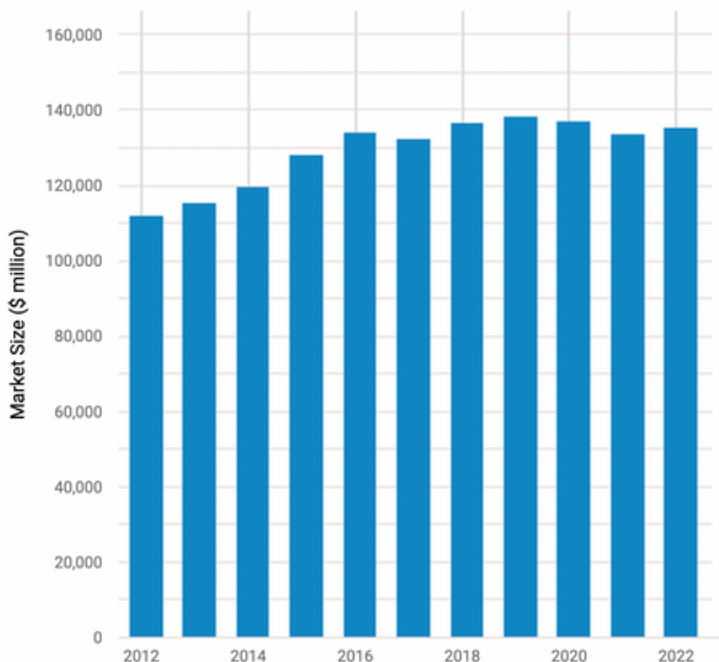

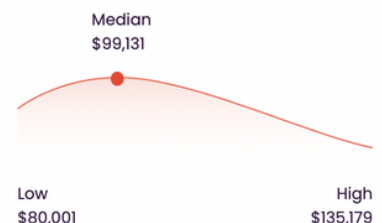
Market size of education in Australia

Some job roles may require tasks to be performed with a moderate level of autonomy and/or the provision of management/leadership to other staff/volunteers

Entry Requirements

The target learner for this course must:

- Be over 15 years of age, who have finished or left secondary school
- Obtain a security clearance*
- Ability to undertake a vocational placement, which includes manual handling tasks
- Undertake a language, literacy and numeracy (LLN) skills indicator questionnaire
- Have technological skills to undertake computer/online work and have access to a computer and an up-to-date software.

Enrolment Requirements

To enrol in this course you must provide -

- Proof of ID: Colour copy of Passport or Driver's Licence.
- Unique Student Identification Number (USI)
- Colour copy of Certificates and Statement Results for any previously attained or partially completed qualifications completed in or recognised in Australia.

Vocational Placement

All students will be required to complete either a Vocational placement Log Book or if an Existing worker, a Workplace log book of at least 100 hours within an approved primary or secondary school setting. DP Training has a partnership with education providers with whom we will coordinate your placement. For those who do not wish to attend DP Training's selected placement, you will have the opportunity, in coordination with DP Training to source your own alternative vocational work placement location.

It is a requirement to obtain a security clearance* before you can commence your placement. If you already have a security clearance* please provide a copy with your enrolment. If not, you will need to apply for one upon course commencement.

*Security Clearance: Some qualifications require a security clearance (e.g., police check, valid blue card and/or yellow card) in order for the student to be eligible to undertake practical and/or vocational placement. Additionally, individual host organisations may have different requirements regarding vaccinations. Please discuss these with our Administration Team during the enrolment process and/or refer to the DP Training website for more information. Please note there are mandatory vaccination requirements within each state and it is up to the student to ensure they are complying with their own state, territory legislation and workplace organisation policies and procedures.
