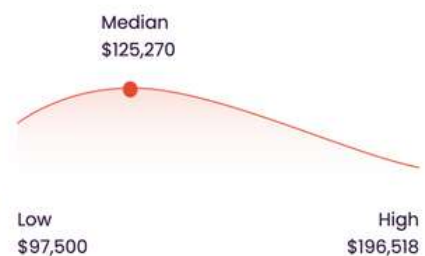

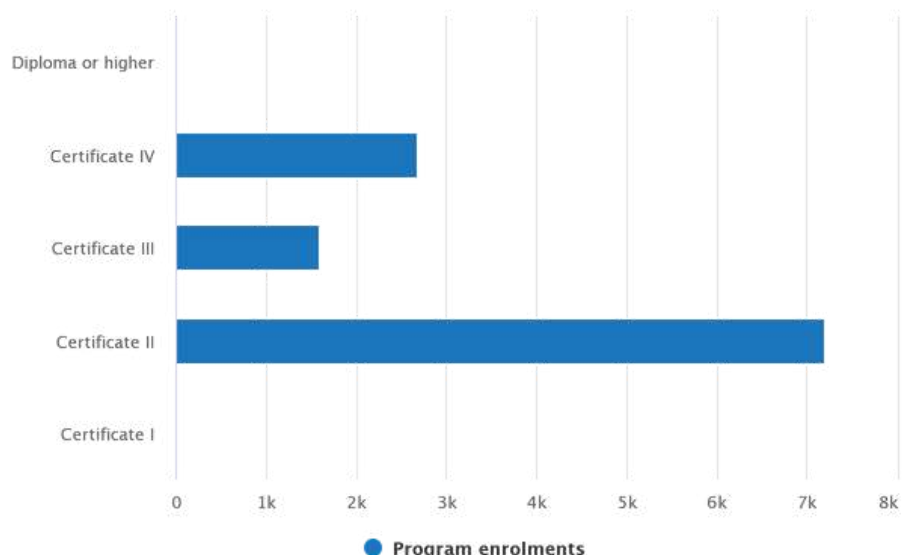
The average rail salary in Australia is **\$125,270** per year or **\$64.24** per hour. Entry-level positions start at **\$97,500** per year, while most experienced workers make up to **\$196,518** per year.

Course Information

This is a general qualification for a person engaged in basic operations within the rail infrastructure environment. It involves undertaking a range of tasks involving known routines and procedures and taking some responsibility for the quality of work outcomes.

There are 16 units of study in this qualification covering topics such as:

- Following work health and safety procedures
- Operate minor mechanical equipment
- Safely access the rail corridor
- Install Railway sleepers

What does the course cover?

By pursuing this qualification, you will learn industry skills such as how to

- Place sleepers across roadbeds, and position and fasten rails on sleepers
- Drill bolt holes, and bolt and weld rail sections
- Remove and replace worn and damaged rails, sleepers and switches
- Clean and lubricate switches
- Install and repair signals and other equipment
- Assist with the righting of derailed rolling stock
